COVID-19 Policies & Procedures Information

For Summer Camps & Reunion Parents, Guardians, Participant, Staff and Campers

Before Arriving at Camp:

- Maintain strict COVID-19 safety guidelines for 10 days before your event.
- All participants who attend must complete the "Lake Doniphan Pre-Screening Form." The form must be completed and turned in during check-in.
- Read and sign the COVID-19 waiver attached to participants' Active Network registration form.
- Bring at least four face masks to use during camp, which include the campers' initials.
- Make sure all fees are paid in full at least one week prior to the start of camp/reunion.

When Arriving at Camp:

- Arrive at camp during your allotted time. More information on this will be sent via email in the coming weeks.
- Only one parent or guardian can arrive with a camper during the check-in/checkout process, no additional family members are allowed.
- Parents or guardians not participating at the event will not be allowed in the cabin room.

During Camp:

Masks:

- Must be worn universally in all indoor locations other than while eating, sleeping, swimming, showering, and brushing teeth. Participants do not have to wear a mask in their private room in the main lodge.
- Masks are required to be worn during outdoor activities when 6 feet distance cannot be maintained, unless swimming or boating.
- We do not allow the use of face coverings or masks that have exhalation valves or vents that allow virus particles to escape.

Cleaning:

- Handwashing will be built into youth camp schedules.
- Doniphan will have an elevated cleaning schedule, and camp will need to clean spaces after each use.

• Cohorts:

- Doniphan will be using cohorts or family groups (10 or less people) to reduce the risk of transmission
- Cohorts will organize staff and campers into "households" who will live, eat, wash, and do many group activities together. Cohorts will be your primary community for camp.
- Some activities may allow for cohort groups to mix, such as elective classes or big events.

Meals:

- o Cohorts will need to eat together. Outdoor dining may be an option.
- Staggered mealtimes may be implemented.
- All food and drinks will be served by designated staff, including breakfast & salad bar.

Other:

- It is highly recommended the participant receives a vaccination if the participant is eligible.
- o Daily temperature checks will be implemented.
- Participants will not be able to leave the grounds and return to camp during the middle of the experience.
- Campers in mini lodges will be required to keep their personal belongings in their designated spaces.
