

# **SPECTACULAR COVID-19 Protocol - 2022**

## **Vaccination Requirements for SPECTACULAR**

SPECTACULAR and its organizers, staff, delegation leaders/staff and campers are required to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19.

You are considered fully vaccinated when:

- You have completed the primary vaccine series and received a booster.

-OR -

- You have completed the primary vaccine series between February and July 2022.

**To be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 by the start of SPECTACULAR complete the primary vaccine series or get your booster by July 1.**

Any medical exceptions must be communicated to SPECTACULAR leadership no less than 30 days in advance of the event. Individuals that are medically excluded from this requirement are required to be tested for COVID-19 and to receive a negative test result the day before they arrive on campus.

Vaccine cards and negative test results will be documented and filed by SPEC Registration Staff.

## **Mitigating the Spread of COVID-19 at SPEC**

**It's simple: We trust health care professionals. The health of our SPEC community is our first priority. The safest way to enjoy group activities right now is to be vaccinated against COVID-19. To ensure a safe event and a lasting tradition, we ask the following of all attendees:**

All individuals involved with SPEC will be vaccinated against COVID-19 unless a valid medical exception is presented. Individuals that are medically excluded from this requirement are required to be tested for COVID-19 and to receive a negative test result before being on campus.

**What SPEC Provides:**

1. A team of vaccinated staff members will be dedicated to regularly sanitizing high-touch surfaces throughout campus.
2. Signage across the campus with tips to help prevent the spread of disease or infection will be placed.
3. Hand sanitizer will be readily available at all tents, stage, food areas, lounges, restrooms, residence halls, etc.
4. All Delegation leaders and staff will be notified of current guidelines via email in the week prior to SPEC.

We acknowledge that breakthrough cases are uncommon. However, masks are heavily encouraged for all individuals onsite, in spaces where social distancing is not possible.

**Do not attend SPEC if any of the following is true for you:**

- **Within 10 days** prior to attending SPEC, you have tested positive, or been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19
- **Within 48 hours** prior to attending SPEC, you have experienced symptoms of COVID-19 (e.g., a fever of 100.4 or higher, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking muscle pain/achiness, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, nasal congestion, runny nose, vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue, or any other symptoms associated with COVID-19 identified by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.)
- **Within 14 days** prior of attending SPEC, you have traveled to any international territory identified by federal or applicable state or local governments as being subject to travel or quarantine advisories due to COVID-19.

**Proof of vaccination can include:**

- photocopy of your valid vaccine card
- photo of your valid vaccine card

**To be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 by the start of SPECTACULAR complete the primary vaccine series or get your booster by July 1.**
